Details

NSSA are pleased to announce that the Double Handed 2 Boat Team Racing Championship event will take place in March 2024, to be hosted by Banbury SC, Boddington Reservoir, Boddington NN11 6XU and will again be a two day event.

Sailing

Teams of sailors with experience of team racing will sail Firefly dinghies in the Championship Fleet. Less experienced and/or younger sailors will sail Feva dinghies in the Regatta Fleet.

Facilities, Food and Accommodation

There are good changing facilities and showers at the sailing club, along with a large car park. Hot and cold drinks will be available at the club to purchase during the event. Caravans and motorhomes (not tents) are able to stay overnight at the club. Hotel accommodation can be found nearby in a number of chain hotels, and there are local camp sites for tents. Teams are required to organize their own accommodation.

Costs

Entry Fee for Firefly Championship Fleet	£200 per team of four sailors (sailing Firefly dinghies)
Entry Fee for Feva Regatta Fleet	£200 per team of four sailors (sailing Feva dinghies)
Damage Deposit	£100

Entry Forms, Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

The NSSA website will be updated with the Notice of Race, Entry Form, Parent/Guardian Declaration and Sailing Instructions when they are available.

How to Enter

Requirements to enter a team to the event:

- All competitors must be aged 18 or under on 31st August in the year of the event.
- Competitors in the Regatta Fleet must be aged 16 or under on 31st August in the year of the event.
- The team must be a group member of NSSA for the current membership year, 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2024. NSSA Membership must be organized before submitting an entry.
- Competitors must be an individual member of NSSA for the current membership year, 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2024. NSSA Membership must be organized before submitting an entry.
- Competitors can only enter as part of a team of four in the Firefly Championship Fleet and Feva Regatta Fleet
- Competitors must have an adult Team Manager to be responsible for the team(s) and be named on the NSSA Entry Form.
- Full payment for team entry must be made by BACS to NSSA account (details on entry form).
- Parents must complete a NSSA Parent/Guardian Declaration Form which is returned to the Team Manager. No form = no sailing!
- Team manager must produce a NSSA Parent/Guardian Declaration for all sailors in their team(s) at registration of the event.
- Entries are limited and will be allocated based on receipt of a completed entry form, full payment of entry fee, full details of NSSA membership for both sailors and the team and other entries from the similar area. If the event is over subscribed, the NSSA Sailing Committee will reduce the team entries, taking into consideration the above criteria.

What's Next

- This event is a limited entry event so teams / counties / clubs will initially be offered two entries for each of the fleets, to enable us to offer as many teams as possible the opportunity to take part.
- The event cannot operate without volunteer adult helpers from each team who take part. When completing the entry form please provide one named adult helper per team who is able to assist on the water or on land. Failure to supply these adult helpers will result in a £10 per team supplement to entry fee.
